OBEDIENCE "C" MATCH

Practice run-throughs will occur in the obedience rings 30 minutes after the conclusion of the obedience trial and rally trials. No food will be allowed in the ring, but toys may be permitted. Corrections shall be limited to verbal corrections or gentle guidance of the dog. Handlers may elect to do a complete or partial run-through of Novice, Open, Utility or request 7 minutes in the ring to practice whatever exercises desired.

ENTRY FEES

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS:

All rings shall be constructed of wood gates.

HVOC allows 'NO SMOKING' on their training grounds. There will be a designated smoking area posted outside the fence.

Move-ups will be allowed at this trial. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in obedience who come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Superintendent. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening date of the show or given to the Show Superintendent 1/2 hour before the start of the show.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

Do Not Park on Dog Park Side of Parking Lot Follow Signs to Designated Parking Area

SR78 to I-15 North, exit El Norte Pkwy. Turn right on El Norte Pkwy and follow to East Valley Pkwy and turn left. Go past Eureka Springs residential area and turn left at traffic light at Beven Drive. Parking for trial will be in open field to your right.

From I-15 Southbound: Exit El Norte Parkway. Turn left (East) onto El Norte Parkway. Stay on El Norte to East Valley Parkway. Turn left on East Valley Parkway. Go past Eureka Springs residential area and turn left at traffic light at Beven Drive. Parking for trial will be in open field on your right.

From I-15 Northbound: Exit Via Rancho Parkway. Go north for about 6 miles on Via Rancho which becomes Bear Valley Parkway until it ends at East Valley Parkway. Turn right onto East Valley Parkway. Go past Washington/El Norte Parkway and Eureka Springs residential area and turn left at traffic light at Beven Drive. Parking for trial will be in open field on your right

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SHOW RULES

1. Entries must reach the Event Secretary by 6:00pm (PST), Wednesday, October 6, 2010. Fees must accompany entries. This club and/or its event secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its event secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
 2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check **must be made good** by cash or money order **before** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
 3. Exhibitors' conformation slips and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the secretary. Conformation slips and judging programs returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held by the Secretary.
 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The AKC that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7am-6 pm.
 5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who is considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging the breed. Notify the secretary of any discrepancy. No trophies or prizes will be mailed.
 6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available at the Secretary's table at the show or may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606.
 7. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
 8. **NO SMOKING ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.** Smoking allowed in designated smoking areas only
 9. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry.
 10. No ineligible dog will be allowed on the trial grounds.
 11. Declination of Entries. The Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
 12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
 13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Hidden Valley Obedience Club of North San Diego, Inc, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
 14. Matting is required in all exercise pens.
 15. A Recording Fee of 50¢ for each first entry, an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for each first entry and for each Recordable Single Entry, and a \$3.00 Rally Trial Fee for each entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the AKC. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
 16. **BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT PERMITTED TO COMPETE** in obedience trials. Hidden Valley Obedience Club will refund all but \$2.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for this reason. Request for refund must be given to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the judging or by letter postmarked not later than the day before the opening of the trial.
 17. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class (i.e. novice to open) and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.
 18. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
 19. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
 20. All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or exercising ring or confined in crates.
 21. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.
